The debarment of the three British-registered corporations (Crown Sakura Ltd.; Chase Berkeley Cavendish Ltd. and Amani BP Ltd.) is permanent and was ordered by World Bank President James Wolfensohn who acted on the recommendation of the Bank's Sanctions Committee.
